
Emissions Reduction Targets


In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next 5 years 2023-2028 to 1,138,520kg CO2e. This represents a reduction of 35% from 2019.

Carbon Reduction Projects

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed and implemented since the 2019 baseline:

- Adoption of LED lighting with PIR sensors across UK offices and technical training centres
- Travel policy changes to reduce company travel by encouraging the use of video conferencing
- Supporting the company's flexible working policy to minimise employee commuting
- Company vehicle policy changes to introduce the use of hybrid vehicles
- Procurement of green energy where possible

In the future, we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Energy efficiency projects for the buildings within our supply chain including procurement of green energy, introduction of solar power, reduced gas consumption
- Introduction of electrical vehicles and EV charging points
- Optimised recycling and waste minimisation
- Optimisation of logistics, including the use of the NHS supply chain back-haul transport facility
